SCARF-FACE ROBBER HITS AGAIN

On January 11, 2010, at approximately 3:10 a.m., the "scarf-face robber" robbed a business in the area of Pecos and Washington. The suspect, wearing a scarf over his face, a black puffy hooded jacket and blue jeans cuffed at the ankle, jumped the counter, produced a gun and demanded money. The employee complied, the suspect then fled.

***** PREVIOUSLY RELEASED INFORMATION (01/11/10) *****

During the months of December 2009 and January 2010, there have been eleven business robberies in Northeast area of Las Vegas involving what appears to be the same African American male suspect. During each robbery, the suspect points a firearm at the employee and demands money. In each event, the suspect wears a scarf over his face and either a black puffy hooded jacket or a white and blue hooded Dodgers jacket.

The first event occurred on December 19, 2009. The latest event occurred on January 7, 2010. In the January 7th event, the clerk shot at the suspect who then fled without any money. The shots are believed to have missed the suspect. Half of the robberies have occurred from 2:30-4:30 a.m. The other half have occurred between 12:50 and 6:00 p.m.
