**METRO INVESTIGATES APPARENT SHOOTING
DEATHS OF THREE INDIVIDUALS**

On January 10, 2010, L.V.M.P.D. patrol officers responded to the 1800 block of Warrentville Street to investigate a report two individuals had been shot.

Arriving officers located an African-American male adult outside the residence, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound to the head. Upon entry to the residence officers located the bodies of two Caucasian females, also deceased from apparent gunshot wounds.

Medical personnel responded to the scene and pronounced the two females deceased. The male was transported to University Medical Center where he succumbed to his injuries on January 11th, 2010.

Homicide Detectives learned the male, who has been identified by the Clark County Coroners Office as Gregg Thomas, 23 years of age of Las Vegas, forced his way into the residence on Warrenville and shot the two female victims. The identities of the two female victims, one 50 years of age of Las Vegas and her 22 year old daughter, also of Las Vegas, along with the exact cause and manner of death, will be released by the Clark County Coroners Office.
