**METRO DETECTIVES SEEK PUBLIC ASSISTANCE
IN SOLVING THREE YEAR OLD HOMICIDE**

On February 10th, 2007, at approximately 6:35 a.m. Rudy Brieno, a 31 year old father of three from California, was shot and killed during an altercation outside of Cheetah's Gentleman's Club, 2112 Western Avenue, in Las Vegas Nevada. The altercation involved a group of Hispanic males who argued and then fought with a group of African American males.

The initial investigation led Detectives to seek two vehicles:

- A white four-door sedan, possibly a Lexus, with dark tinted windows and chrome wheels, and possibly bearing California license plates. This vehicle is shown in photo # 6 which accompanies this release. It is indicated in the photograph by a red arrow, and
- A dark green four-door Pontiac Grand Prix, also with dark tinted windows and chrome wheels. This vehicle is depicted in photo # 5, which also accompanies this release.

Additionally, the individual's depicted in photographs 1 through 4, which accompany this release, are considered persons of interest in this case.

The vehicles referenced above have not been located, and the persons of interest remain un-identified.
