CIVIL JUDGEMENT DOCUMENTS SERVED AT NEWTON RESIDENCE

At approximately 9:00 a.m. this morning Deputies assigned to the Sheriff's Civil Process Section presented civil judgement documents at the residence of Mr. Wayne Newton, 6629 S. Pecos in Southeast Las Vegas.

The documents which the Deputies presented were issued pursuant to District Court Judgement A-591999, and associated with court documents filed under case number A-09-591999-F.

Security personnel present at the residence refused to accept service of the documents, and the deputies left the area at approximately 9:40 a.m.. The civil judgement documents will now be returned to District Court as "un-executed", and no further service will be attempted pending further civil court actions.

The Sheriff's Civil Process Division consists of 15 Category 1 Peace Officers who report to personnel within the Clark County Detention Center. Their primary responsibilities include the service of civil judgments such as those involved in this mornings case, as well as restraining and, stalking and harassment orders, along with other court documents.

The Metro Office of Public Information apologizes for the incorrect information we released this morning concerning this incident prior to our complete knowledge of this event.
