On May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 at approximately 9:18 a.m., officers from the Boulder City Police Department observed a SUV parked in the desert area off of Interstate 95, at mile marker 52. The SUV took off at a high rate of speed and a vehicle stop was conducted. The patrol officer, while conducting his investigation sent another officer over to the area where he had first observed the SUV. The second officer located the body of a Hispanic female who appeared to be deceased.

While Boulder City Police detectives were conducting their investigation, it was determined that the homicide occurred in the Las Vegas area. Detectives from LVMPD Homicide were requested and assisted the Boulder City Police Department with the investigation. The suspect was identified as Harold Marin-Velasquez, a 34 year old Las Vegas resident. Marin-Velasquez was arrested for Murder and booked into Clark County Detention Center.

The decedent was identified as Edis Hernandez, a 43 year old resident of Las Vegas, by the Clark County Coroner's Office.
