On May 18, 2010 at approximately 1830 hours, two armed suspects entered a man's apartment in the area of the 5200 block of Alpine Pl. with the intention of committing a residential robbery. During the robbery, the victim was shot in the left chest area and the suspects fled.

Detectives quickly located the suspect's car and vehicle pursuit ensued. One suspect was let out of the car in the Southeast part of the valley, near Starlight Canyon and Sunlight Canyon. He was taken into custody after a short foot pursuit. The driver continued to attempt to evade police and the pursuit terminated at Pecos and Patrick, when the suspect's vehicle collided with a large bus in the intersection. There were no injuries as a result of this accident.

The driver was then taken into custody at the termination point without incident. Both suspects were charged with Kidnap with a Deadly Weapon, Burglary with a Deadly Weapon, Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Conspiracy to commit Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Attempt Murder and Felony Evading.

The victim was treated for his gunshot and released from the hospital.
