- Sexual content;
- Solicitations of commerce;
- Conduct, encouragement, promote, or incite criminal or illegal activity or comments that otherwise incite imminent lawless action;
- Information that may tend to compromise the safety or security of the public or public systems;
- Content that violates a legal ownership interest of any other party or
- Apparent spam or trolling.
