KEY CONCLUSIONS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND OUTCOMES OF A CATEGORICAL USE OF FORCE INCIDENT
Officer-Involved Shooting — 2420 East Desert Inn Road on October 29, 2012

Purpose:

The purpose of this report is to publish key conclusions, recommendations and outcomes of the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's internal review of this incident. There are a variety of actions that can be taken administratively in response to the Department's review of a deadly force incident. The review may reveal that no action is required or determine that additional training is appropriate for all officers in the workforce, or only for the involved officer(s). The review may reveal the need for changes in departmental policies, procedures, or rules. Where departmental rules have been violated, formal discipline may be appropriate. The goal of the review is to improve both individual and the agency's performance.

Synopsis of Event:

On October 29, 2012, at approximately 1453 hours, officers responded to a call of a person shot at the Ross Dress for Less clothing store located at 2420 East Desert Inn Road. An LVMPD cadet arrived on scene and observed an individual matching the shooting suspect's description sitting at the loading dock located to the rear of the business. Officer Wimmer responded to the loading dock area and attempted to engage the suspect, later identified as Ronald James Morrison. Morrison refused all verbal direction. Officers Iacullo and Henry responded to assist Officer Wimmer after she broadcasted Morrison was not obeying her commands. After Officers Iacullo and Henry arrived at Officer Wimmer's side, Morrison produced a firearm. Officers Wimmer, Henry, and Iacullo fired their handguns at Morrison, striking him. Morrison fell to the ground and was unresponsive.

Medical, still on the scene of the initial shooting, responded to the rear of the Ross. Morrison was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The Criminal Investigation:

LVMPD Force Investigation Team (FIT) conducted the criminal investigation of this incident. Their investigation was submitted to the District Attorney's Office for review. In their examination of the FIT case, the District Attorney's Office determined, "the actions of Officers Wimmer, Henry and Iacullo were reasonable and legally justified."

LVMPD's Use of Force Review Board:

1. The matter involving Officers Wimmer, Henry, and Iacullo was heard by the Use of Force Review Board on October 21, 2013. The Board's finding for each involved officer was

"Administrative Approval." The Use of Force Review Board determined the officers' actions were within policy. The Sheriff approved the Board's recommendation.

2. The internal review concluded the officers' performance was in accordance with Department standardized tactics and training.
