III. INCIDENT DETAILS

On March 15, 2019, detectives assigned to the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) Southern Nevada Counter Terrorism Center's (SNCTC) Central Intelligence Unit (CIU) were located inside of the surveillance room of the Bellagio Las Vegas (Bellagio) at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. due to working a kidnapping investigation that resulted in an arrest. During the course of that investigation, the detectives requested additional patrol resources, which brought numerous uniformed patrol officers to the Bellagio property.

While the detectives were reviewing video surveillance of the arrest associated with the kidnapping, they were advised by Bellagio surveillance officers of a robbery which had occurred inside the poker room at the cage. The surveillance officers were able to locate the male suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, who had robbed the cage and followed his movements via video surveillance as he exited the doors to the north valet. Because of the previous kidnapping call, a group of LVMPD uniformed bicycle patrol officers were still on scene in the north valet area as Cohen exited.

As Cohen entered the north valet, he walked directly to a white vehicle parked along the curb, entered the vehicle, and then immediately exited. Cohen then walked west in the driveway to a black vehicle that had pulled up behind him. As he reached the driver's door, he grabbed the handle and attempted to open the door, but the door did not open. Cohen attempted to open the door multiple times as the driver of the vehicle drove forward and neared where the group of bicycle officers were located.

As the vehicle moved forward, Cohen pulled a handgun from his jacket pocket and used it to tap the driver's window. The CIU detectives, who were watching Cohen in real time from the surveillance office, used their LVMPD radios to broadcast to the bicycle officers that Cohen had just committed a robbery (Cohen was later found to be in possession of a plastic grocery style bag which contained \$72,350 in Bellagio poker chips and U.S. currency), his description, and his location. The officers in the north valet dismounted their bikes and proceeded toward Cohen at the driver's side of the vehicle.

Officers Preston Ellis, Devin McHale, and Gabriel Lea moved around the front of the vehicle as Officer Joaquin Escobar moved around the rear. Cohen pointed his handgun at Officer Ellis as he passed the front of the vehicle and moved toward him. Cohen fired one time, striking Officer Ellis in the chest. Cohen then ran north across the valet driveway, and Officer Ellis fell

backward, knocking down Officers McHale and Lea, who immediately scrambled to take cover. Officer Escobar immediately chased after Cohen. He fired one round at Cohen, which struck him in the head and caused him to fall to the ground. The officers moved to Cohen's location, kicked the gun out from under his body as they took him into custody, and requested medical aid for him.

Cohen and Officer Ellis were both transported to University Medical Center (UMC) Trauma Center for evaluation and treatment. The round fired by Cohen at Officer Ellis struck Officer Ellis' cell phone, which had been in his shirt pocket, and deflected into his bulletproof vest, stopping the bullet. Cohen was pronounced deceased at 0317 hours on March 16, 2019.

Due to the officer-involved shooting (OIS) aspect of the incident, detectives from the Force Investigation Team (FIT) were requested and responded to the scene to conduct the investigation.

Following the briefing, Detective Leavitt was assigned as the lead case agent and tasked with the responsibility of documenting the crime scene with crime scene analysts. Detectives Aisup, Colon, Mendoza, Patton, Ubbens, and Zinger were assigned to interview available witnesses and conduct weapon count downs. Detective Penny was assigned responsibilities at the hospital, which included interviewing any possible witnesses.

IV. BODY WORN CAMERAS

Officers Joaquin Escobar and Devin McHale were each wearing a body worn camera (BWC) at the time of the incident and their cameras were activated.

Officer Joaquin Escobar

Officer Escobar's BWC was collected by Sergeant Ericsson and secured. The video footage captured was later viewed by Officer Escobar at approximately 0220 hours on March 16, 2019.

Officer Escobar's camera footage depicted a group of uniformed LVMPD bicycle patrol officers underneath the north valet canopy of the Bellagio. To the left of the officers (north), vehicles were stopped in the valet lanes of the driveway, and a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, was seen walking west in the driveway. Cohen was dressed in all dark clothing which included a beanie, glasses, jacket, pants and shoes. Cohen appeared to have a large, white bandage across the left side of his face, and he carried a plastic bag. The bicycle officers seemed to notice Cohen, but did not react to his presence as he walked out of BWC view.

The officers appeared to be engaged in conversation among themselves when, approximately 16 seconds later, Officer Ellis, who was in front of Officer Escobar, appeared to grab the radio on his uniform belt and looked toward where Cohen had gone. All of the officers immediately dismounted their bicycles, dropped them, and moved toward the driveway. Officer Escobar ran behind a vehicle closest to the curb of the driveway and drew his firearm as he ran. As Officer Escobar moved north across the driveway, Cohen could be seen running between vehicles. Officer Escobar's weapon was pointed directly at Cohen. Officer Escobar then fired one round, though no gunshot was heard.¹ Officer Escobar neared the north side of the driveway, where

¹ Although the BWC is always recording video, audio is not captured until the camera is activated. Thirty seconds of footage playback will be captured prior to the start of the audio recording.

Cohen fell to the ground behind a vehicle. As Officer Escobar approached, Cohen was lying face down with his head pointing to the east, between two vehicles. As Officer Escobar moved closer to Cohen, the vehicle furthest to the north and next to Cohen proceeded to drive forward leaving the valet driveway.

Officer Escobar yelled out Cohen's location to the other officers and told them to get medical personnel on scene. Officer Escobar knelt down and placed Cohen in handcuffs as another officer kicked a gun away from Cohen's body.

Officer Devin McHale

Officer McHale's BWC was collected by Sergeant Ericsson and secured. The video footage captured was later viewed by Officer McHale at approximately 0242 hours on March 16, 2019.

Officer McHale's camera footage depicted him in the north valet lot of the Bellagio. Officer McHale's camera faced northeast toward the valet driveway, where several vehicles stopped or were parked. Officer McHale got off of his bicycle and immediately rushed toward the northwest with other uniformed LVMPD bicycle patrol officers. Officer Ellis was in front of Officer McHale as they moved around the front of a black vehicle which was stopped along the curb next to them. As the two officers moved around the front of the vehicle, Officer Ellis quickly stopped his forward momentum and backed up toward the sidewalk. As Officer Ellis backed up, Officer McHale went down to the ground, drew his firearm, and took cover behind the front passenger side wheel of the vehicle. Officer McHale looked over the hood of the vehicle and could be heard yelling, "Where's he at?" A voice yelled back, and Officer McHale moved behind the vehicle and made his way north across the driveway and joined Officer Escobar.

As Officer McHale joined Officer Escobar, a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, was face down on the driveway. Cohen's body was lying with his head to the east, and his feet, which were nearest to Officer McHale, to the west. Cohen wore a jacket that was bunched up around his upper body and head area, and his arms were tucked under his head. Officer Escobar grabbed Cohen's arm to place him in handcuffs, and as he pulled the right arm out from under Cohen's body a handgun was visible, which Officer Ellis immediately kicked away from Cohen.

Officer Ellis wiped his face and asked the officers if he was bleeding, to which they responded he was. Officer McHale let his BWC continue to run as additional units responded to assist, the scene was locked down, and Cohen was transported from the scene.

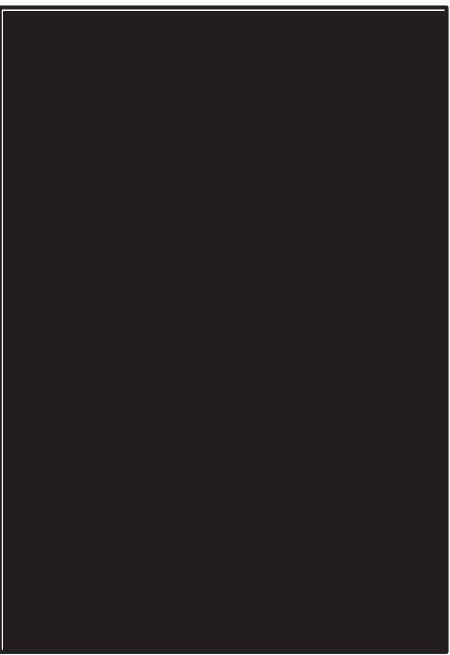
V. HOSPITAL

Location and Description of the Body

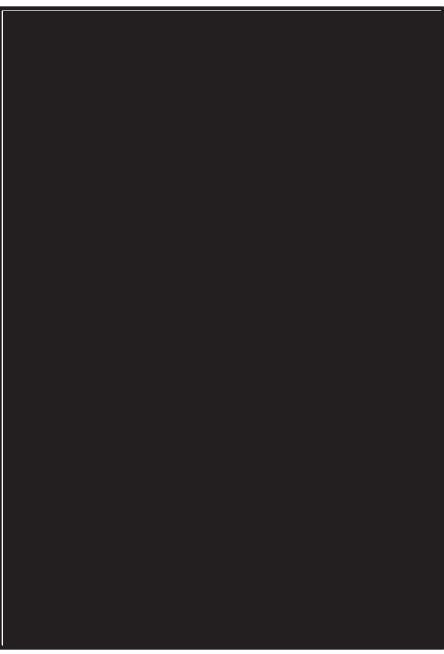

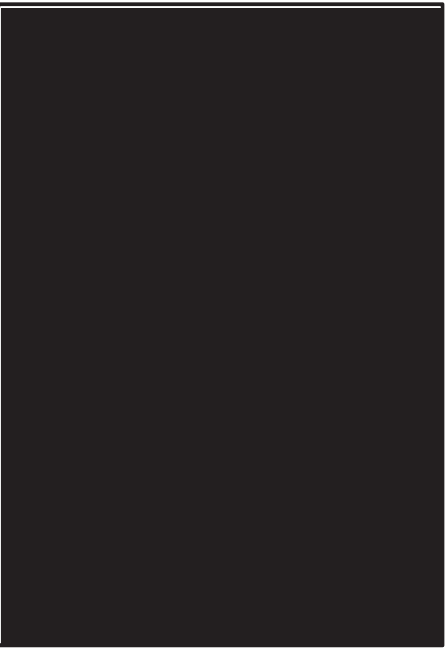

VI. SCENE WALK-THROUGHS

The purpose of the scene walk-through was to help investigators develop an understanding of the scene, including identifying officer location(s) at the time deadly force was used, identifying potential physical evidence, and re-creating a timeline of the incident.

Officer Joaquin Escobar

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0232 hours, Officer Escobar provided a walk-through of the scene in the presence of the following persons:

During the walk-through, which was not video or audio recorded, Officer Escobar relayed the following information:

Officer Escobar stated he observed Cohen prior to the shooting because of something on Cohen's face. Officer Escobar heard radio traffic reference a robbery, and he heard Officer Ellis state, "Metro Police." Officer Escobar then identified the location where he perceived he was standing when Cohen fired his gun. The location indicated was next to the front passenger side door of a black BMW sedan. CSA Supervisor Wilson marked Officer Escobar's location with an orange traffic cone.

Officer Escobar stated he fired his weapon for the safety of his partner and people in the valet lot. Officer Escobar identified his perceived location, as well as Cohen's location, when he fired his weapon at Cohen. CSA Supervisor Wilson marked both locations with orange traffic cones.

Officer Devin McHale

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0248 hours, Officer McHale provided a walk-through of the scene in the presence of the following persons:

During the walk-through, which was not video or audio recorded, Officer McHale relayed the following information:

Officer McHale started his walk-through at the location where he left his police bicycle which was the farthest east of the group of bicycles. Officer McHale did not observe Cohen's actions or notice Cohen's gun. Officer McHale was alerted to Cohen after hearing Cohen's description broadcast over the police radio.

Officer McHale identified the location where he perceived Cohen was standing when Cohen fired his gun. The location indicated was next to the driver's side front tire of a black BMW sedan. CSA Supervisor Wilson marked the location with an orange traffic cone.

Officer McHale stated he did not hear or see any officers fire their handguns.

Officer Gabriel Lea

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0259 hours, Officer Lea provided a walk-through of the scene in the presence of the following persons:

Officer Lea was alerted to Cohen after hearing Cohen's description broadcast over the police radio.

Officer Lea identified the location where he perceived Cohen was standing when Cohen fired his gun. The location indicated was next to the driver's side front door of a black BMW sedan. CSA Supervisor Wilson marked the location with an orange traffic cone.

Officer Lea stated he did not hear or see any officers fire their handguns.

VII. PUBLIC SAFETY STATEMENT

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0051 hours, Detective Alsup interviewed Sergeant Kelvington in reference to the Public Safety Statement he obtained from Officer Escobar.

Note: Detective Alsup is designated by (TA) and Sergeant Kelvington is designated by (AK).

TA: *This is Detective Trevor Alsup, P# 5782, uh, conducting a Public Safety Statement with Sergeant Andy, A-N-D-Y, Kelvington, K-E-L-V-I-N-G-T-O-N. His P#'s 8878, and his call sign tonight is 590. Officer Ellis' handgun was carried on the right side of his body and secured in a holster.

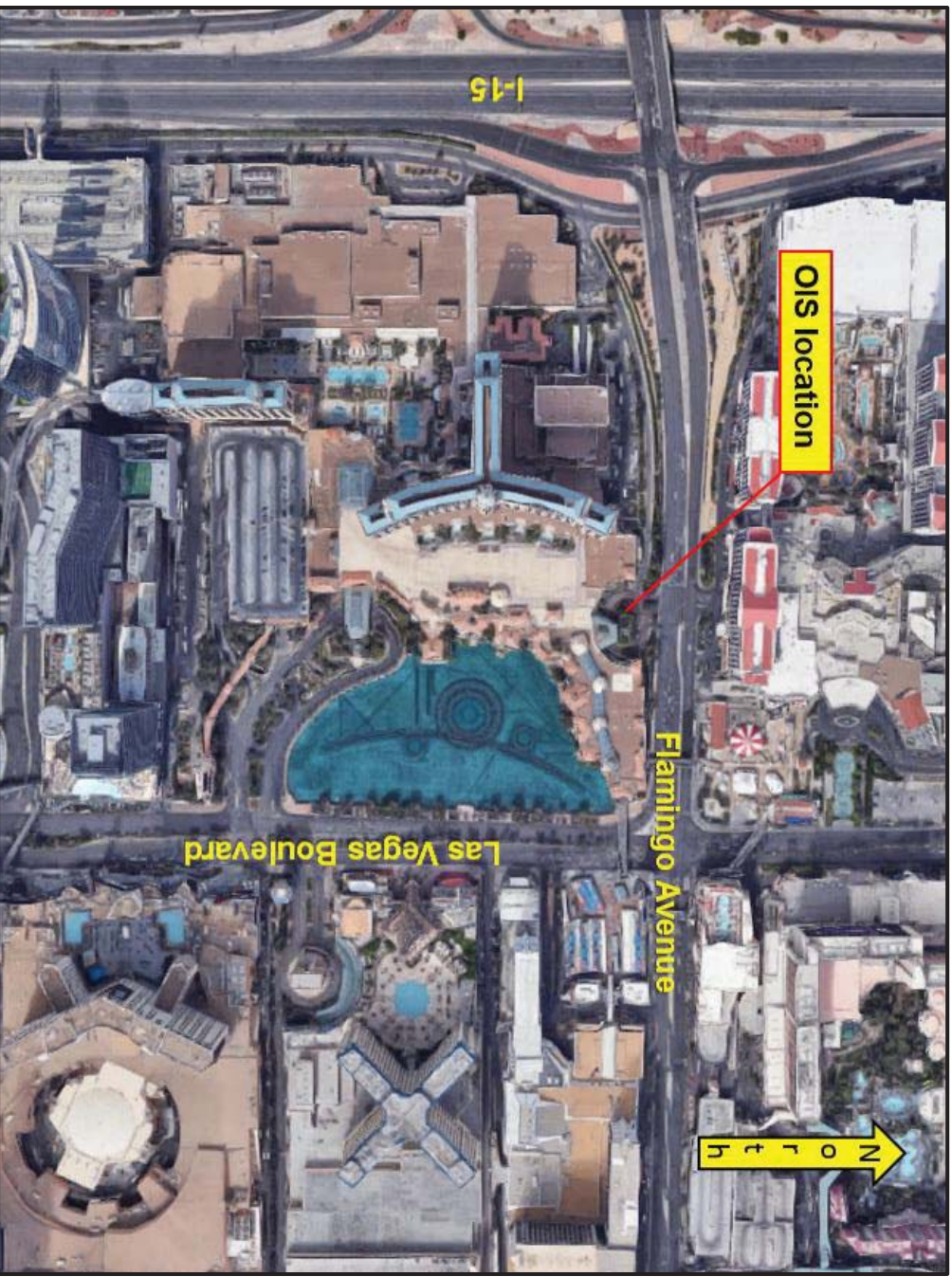

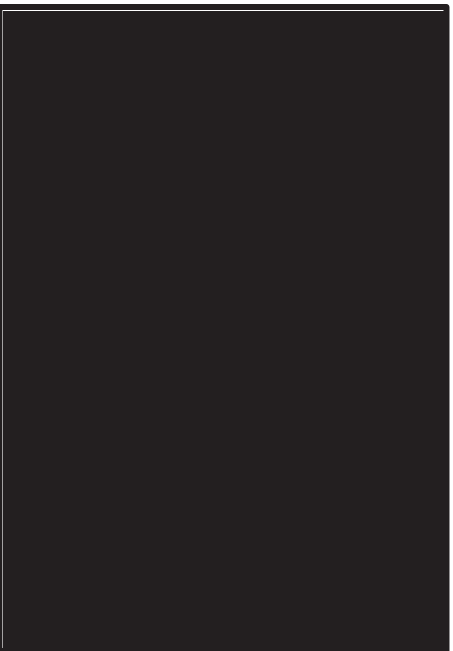

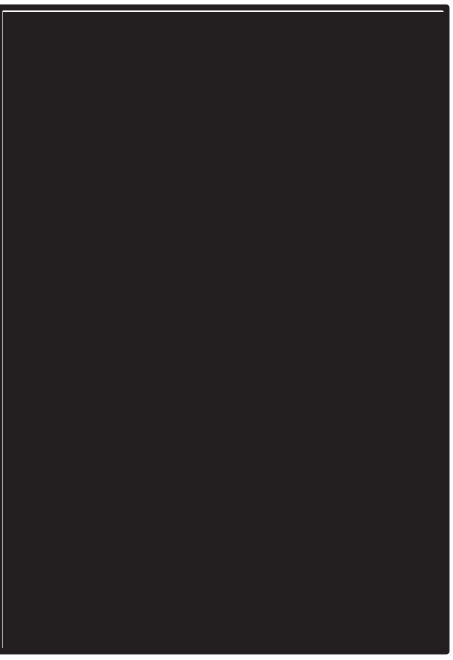

Above: Crime scene diagram depicting the north valet lot and driveways

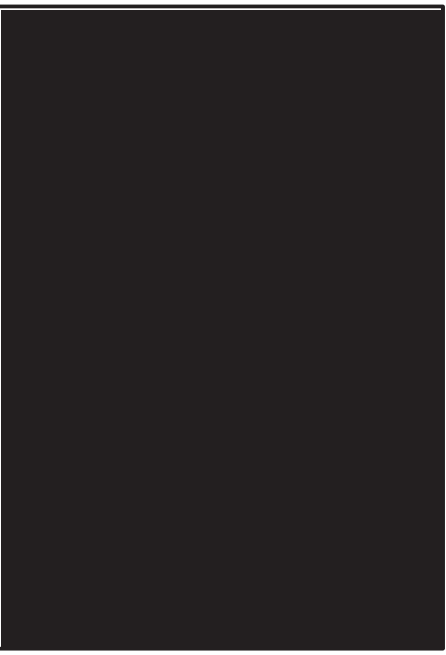
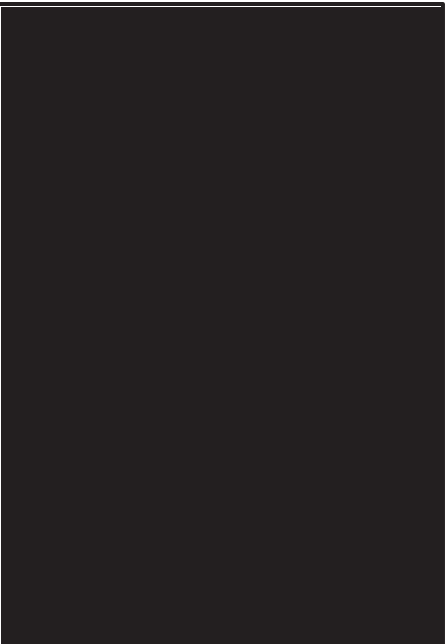

XI. THIRD PARTY VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHIC EVIDENCE

Bellagio North Valet Stationary Driveway Camera

The Bellagio north valet stationary driveway camera was mounted above the doors to the hotel. This camera faced northwest and showed the pedestrian walkway and vehicles arriving in the north valet.

The video footage captured showed a group of four LVMPD bicycle patrol officers off to the left of the screen on the pedestrian walkway. At approximately 21:46:05, per the camera's internal clock, a male subject, later identified as Michael Cohen, walked north across the bottom of the screen into the valet driveway. Cohen walked in front of an unoccupied vehicle parked closest to the pedestrian walkway in the valet driveway, approached the driver's door, opened it, and sat down in the driver's seat. Cohen sat in the driver's seat for approximately three seconds before exiting the vehicle and walking west in the driveway toward an approaching vehicle entering the valet lot.

As Cohen approached the vehicle that entered, he immediately moved to the driver's door. Due to the angle of the camera, Cohen was visible at the door, but his actions could not be seen. Cohen stood at the door for approximately 10 seconds before the vehicle began to slowly move forward in the driveway. As the vehicle moved forward, Cohen stayed at the driver's door and it appeared as if he was trying to open it. The vehicle moved forward until it was almost directly in front of the officers. The officers dropped their bicycles and ran toward the vehicle. Officer Ellis moved in front of the vehicle and was followed by Officers McHale and Lea; Officer Escobar moved to the rear of the vehicle.

As Officer Ellis moved around the front of the vehicle toward the driver's door, Cohen pointed a firearm at him and fired. Officer Ellis immediately jumped back, colliding with Officers McHale and Lea, and three officers went down to the ground on the passenger side of the vehicle. As soon as the shot was fired, Cohen ran north through the driveway and in between parked vehicles. Officer Escobar pursued Cohen, drew his weapon as he followed, and fired one round at Cohen. Cohen fell forward in between two vehicles just prior to reaching the north side of the driveway. The other officers moved up toward Officer Escobar's location, which was behind a vehicle and out of direct camera view, however, it appeared they took Cohen into custody.

Bellagio North Valet Pan-Tilt-Zoom Driveway Camera

The Bellagio north valet pan-tilt-zoom (PTZ) driveway camera was mounted on the ceiling in the middle of the valet driveway and could be controlled by Bellagio surveillance officers. The Bellagio surveillance room officers had been notified of a robbery in the poker room cage and were able to follow the suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, on camera.

The video footage captured showed Cohen exit the far west doors (right side of screen) into the north valet at a slow run and move directly to a white vehicle parked in the valet driveway against the curb and directly in front of the doors. Cohen wore all dark clothing to include a beanie, jacket, shirt and pants. He appeared to be holding a cell phone to his left ear, using his

cheek and shoulder to hold it in place. He carried a plastic bag in his left hand while his right hand was inside his jacket pocket. Cohen moved around the front of the vehicle and went directly to the driver's door which he opened, and climbed into the driver's seat. The camera was zoomed in to get a closer view of Cohen, who immediately exited the vehicle. Per the camera's internal time clock, Cohen was inside of the vehicle for less than three seconds.

When Cohen exited the vehicle he walked west in the valet driveway toward a black BMW sedan which was pulling into the valet lot. As Cohen moved toward the vehicle, he looked south (to his left) to where a group of four LVMPD uniformed bicycle officers were positioned. Cohen walked slowly toward the driver's door of the BMW, which had come to a stop, and with his left hand, which held a plastic bag, Cohen appeared to grab the door handle multiple times in an attempt to open the door. The door did not open, and Cohen tapped on the driver's side window as the driver slowly drove farther into the valet lot.

Cohen kept his hand on the door handle and moved with the vehicle. He pulled his right hand out of his jacket pocket and held a small frame black handgun which he used to begin tapping on the driver's window. The vehicle accelerated and stopped almost adjacent to the bicycle officers. The officers quickly dismounted their bicycles, dropped them, and moved toward the BMW. Cohen maintained his position at the driver's door as the officers moved toward him. One of the officers, Officer Ellis, moved around the front of the BMW. Cohen pointed his firearm at Officer Ellis, fired, and turned his body to run north across the valet driveway.

As Cohen ran, the surveillance officers followed his movements with the camera. Cohen ran north past two vehicles, and looked back over his right shoulder before falling forward onto the pavement. Cohen's body came to rest on the far north side of the valet driveway in between two vehicles. The driver of the vehicle farthest north and nearest Cohen's head drove away as Officer Escobar approached and took Cohen into custody. Officer Escobar knelt over Cohen as he grabbed Cohen's arms to place him in handcuffs. As Officer Escobar pulled Cohen's right arm from under his body to place it behind his back, Officer Ellis approached and kicked a gun away, which appeared to have still been in Cohen's hand.

Once Cohen was in custody, officers requested medical aid for Cohen, and secured the crime scene.

XII. AUTOPSY

On March 17, 2019, at approximately 0915 hours, under Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner (CCOCME) case 19-01442, an autopsy was performed on the body of Michael Cohen at the CCOCME by Doctor Mancini.

- 2) One (1) bullet and one (1) fragment labeled left C1 vertebrae

The following wounds/injuries were noted on Cohen:

- 1) A penetrating gunshot wound of head
- 2) Injuries related to terminal collapse: abrasions of the face and left upper and lower extremities; contusions of lower lip and chest; lacerations of the face
- 3) Injuries related to resuscitation: multiple anterolateral rib fractures (ribs 2-6 bilaterally); lacerations of the liver; left hemothorax; hemoperitoneum

Upon the completion of toxicology testing, the following results were noted:

- 1) Therapeutic/non-toxic concentrations of hydrocodone, nordiazepam, temazepam, and alprazolam in antemortem (hospital) blood.



After a complete autopsy, Doctor Mancini opined Michael Cohen died as a result of gunshot wound of head. The manner of death was homicide.

Breanne Gladstone

On March 15, 2019, at approximately 2315 hours, Detective Alsup conducted an audio recorded interview with Breanne Gladstone at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Gladstone arrived at the Bellagio and pulled her vehicle into line at the north valet area. While waiting for an attendant to take her vehicle, Gladstone observed several LVMPD officers on bicycles near the entrance/exit doors. Gladstone also observed a male (Michael Cohen) in front of her, standing next to a vehicle.

Gladstone heard the officers yell something like, "Get down!" and then heard a gunshot. The officers dropped their bicycles, moved in various directions, and she heard more gunshots. Although Gladstone did not observe any of the officers or Cohen discharge their firearms, she believed Cohen fired at the officers first. Gladstone based her opinion on the positioning of the officers and Cohen. Gladstone then observed the officers run towards Cohen, who was lying on the ground.

Officer Preston Ellis

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0019 hours, Detective Penny conducted an audio recorded interview with Officer Ellis at UMC Trauma Center. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Steve Grammas. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Officer Ellis, along with Officers Escobar, Lea, and McHale, were in the north valet area of the Bellagio discussing where to go next when Officer Ellis heard radio traffic about a robbery, and the suspect (Michael Cohen) was wearing a beanie. Officer Ellis realized Cohen was right in front of him and was trying to get into two different cars. Officer Ellis moved towards the front of the car Cohen was trying to get into when he saw Cohen aim a handgun at him. The handgun was described as a small, black semiautomatic handgun and was being held in Cohen's right hand. As Cohen aimed the handgun, Officer Ellis heard a loud bang and he immediately moved for cover.

Officer Ellis announced over the radio, "Shots fired," and began to look for Cohen. He then discovered Cohen was down on the ground and requested medical personnel to respond to the scene. A responding sergeant arrived and saw Officer Ellis had holes in his shirt and asked if he had been shot. Officer Ellis didn't think he was, but realized he had a laceration above his left eye. Officer Ellis was being checked by fire department personnel when he removed his cellular phone from his uniform shirt pocket to look at the time and saw the phone was damaged by a bullet. Officer Ellis then told his sergeant he thought he had been shot, and was subsequently transported to UMC Trauma Center to be examined.

Officer Ellis did not hear any gunfire except the initial shot from Cohen.

Farah Hontanosas

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0035 hours, Detective Perkett conducted an audio recorded interview with Farah Hontanosas at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

On March 15, 2019, at approximately 2149 hours, Hontanosas was working in the Bellagio poker room cage when a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, approached her and displayed a small black handgun. Cohen spoke softly as he demanded money from her cashier drawer. Hontanosas did not want to give Cohen the \$5,000 chips, so she gave him lower denominations and U.S. currency. During the robbery, Cohen told Hontanosas, "Give me all your big chips," and "I'll shoot you if you don't give me what I want." Hontanosas pushed the gaming chips and currency across the cage counter and Cohen placed the chips and money in a white plastic grocery bag. Cohen finally walked away from the cage and walked towards the high limit tables. As soon as he left, Hontanosas called security and pushed her panic button.

Marilynn Hodges

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0036 hours, Detective Parra conducted an audio recorded interview with Marilyn Hodges at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

On March 15, 2019, at approximately 2149 hours, Hodges was working as a cashier at the Bellagio poker room casino cage. She was working as Teller #1 when she noticed the suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen. Cohen was wearing a hat, glasses, and had tape on the right side of his cheek. Hodges had a customer at her window, but she observed Cohen walk to Teller #4 (Farah Hontanosas) because it was vacant. Cohen placed a clear grocery bag on the counter in front of Hontanosas.

Hodges observed Cohen walk away with the bag in his hand. A coworker told her to push her alarm because the cage had just been robbed. Hodges stated she and her coworkers saw Cohen walk calmly through the poker room and to the north valet doors. Hodges stated she never saw a gun and did not hear any commands because she was too far away to hear a conversation.

Diane Polo

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0036 hours, Detective Rivera conducted an audio recorded interview with Diane Polo at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Polo was working at the Bellagio poker room as a poker cashier and was stationed at window #2 when she witnessed the suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, standing at window #4 speaking to the cashier. Cohen wore a black beanie, glasses, gray hooded jacket, had tape on the side of his face, and carried a white grocery style bag with green and yellow designs on it.

Polo heard Cohen state, "Give me the big bills, don't make me shoot you. I don't want to shoot you." Polo realized her coworker was being robbed, became scared, and pushed the alarm button at her station. Polo acted like she was still working, so she would not alert Cohen to her actions. Polo then heard Cohen state, "Now give me the big chips, just the big chips. Come on, come on." Cohen exited the poker room towards the sports book, followed the railing, and walked towards the north valet exit. Polo told her supervisor, Brian Kwak, what had occurred.

Lee Bailey

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0039 hours, Detective Shoemaker conducted an audio recorded interview with Lee Bailey at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Bailey stated that she witnessed a white male, later identified as Michael Cohen, wearing jeans, a dark colored hooded sweatshirt, and a black beanie style hat walk through the High Rollers Lounge of the Bellagio. Lee stated Cohen had walked from the sports book.

Lee stated Cohen looked odd to her, and he walked to the cash cage and then walked away. After Cohen walked away, Lee heard someone inside of the cash cage yell, "Don't chase him, he has a gun!" Lee then realized the cash cage had been robbed.

Detective Tara Brosnahan

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0051 hours, Detective Colon conducted an audio recorded interview with Detective Brosnahan at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Scott Nicholas. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Detective Brosnahan was inside the Bellagio's surveillance room working on a case related to her position with the Central Intelligence Unit when the surveillance room officers received a call from casino floor personnel informing them there had just been a robbery in the poker room.

The Bellagio surveillance team located the suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, walking through the casino. Detective Brosnahan knew there were multiple patrol officers in the area that had been working on her event, so Detective Brosnahan broadcast Cohen's description and direction of travel over the police radio.

Detective Brosnahan observed Cohen exit the casino into the north valet area and enter a white Mercedes sedan that was parked in the valet area. Cohen exited the vehicle and approached a black BMW sedan, pulled out a firearm, and appeared to attempt to force the driver to exit.

Detective Brosnahan observed nearby patrol officers approach Cohen, followed by an exchange of gunfire. All of Detective Brosnahan's observations were from watching the surveillance camera's video feed.

Detective Kenneth Ruzicka

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0057 hours, Detective Mendoza conducted an audio recorded interview with Detective Ruzicka at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Myron Hamm. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Detective Ruzicka was at the Bellagio working an incident which involved a kidnapping suspect his team apprehended inside the Bellagio, and while Detective Ruzicka was in the Bellagio surveillance office viewing video of the apprehension he was informed by security that one of the casino cages was actively being robbed. Bellagio security surveillance officers were able to use surveillance cameras to locate the robbery suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, running through the casino. Detective Ruzicka informed other detectives and officers via his radio about the robbery and Cohen's location. Detective Ruzicka observed Cohen enter a white Lexus sedan which was parked in the valet area. Cohen exited the Lexus and walked to another vehicle. Four LVMPD bicycle patrol officers were in the valet area in close proximity to Cohen.

LVMPD Sergeant Whiteley broadcast Cohen's description via his radio and informed the officers that Cohen was involved with the robbery and they needed to apprehend him. Detective Ruzicka continued to watch Cohen on the surveillance monitors as Cohen attempted to carjack a citizen in the valet area. Detective Ruzicka observed Cohen produce a handgun and point it at the driver of the vehicle. As the patrol officers received the information via the police radio regarding the robbery, they noticed Cohen in the valet area. As officers approached Cohen, he fired his handgun one time toward the officers, striking Officer Ellis in the chest area. As Cohen attempted to flee, he was struck with gunfire and fell face first onto the sidewalk. Officers took Cohen into custody after the shooting.

Sergeant Robert Whiteley

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0059 hours, Detective Alsop conducted an audio recorded interview with Sergeant Whiteley at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was LVPMISA representative Michelle Jotz. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Sergeant Whiteley and his team were at the Bellagio working to capture a kidnapping suspect. After the suspect was taken into custody, Sergeant Whiteley and some of his team went to the surveillance room to obtain a copy of the surveillance video from the arrest.

While in the surveillance room, Sergeant Whiteley was looking at a monitor and observed a subject (Michael Cohen) running through the casino. Sergeant Whiteley heard a radio broadcast from Bellagio security advising the poker room cage had been robbed. Sergeant Whiteley and the other people in the surveillance room continued to watch Cohen as he ran through the casino and exited through the doors to the north valet area.

As Cohen exited the casino, Sergeant Whiteley observed four LVMPD bicycle officers near the entrance/exit doors to the north valet. Sergeant Whiteley observed Cohen get into a white

vehicle and then exit the vehicle. Cohen then walked up to a black vehicle and attempted to open the door. Cohen produced what appeared to be a firearm while standing next to the black vehicle.

Sergeant Whiteley broadcast over the radio that Cohen had just robbed the casino and advised the bicycle officers which subject was Cohen. The bicycle officers looked and observed Cohen standing next to the black vehicle, got off their bicycles, and walked toward Cohen.

Cohen observed the officers walking towards him and appeared to discharge his firearm. It appeared to Sergeant Whiteley at least one officer returned gunfire, and Cohen fell to the ground. The officers then took Cohen into custody and requested medical personnel respond to the scene.

Brian Kwak

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0100 hours, Detective Perrett conducted an audio recorded interview with Brian Kwak at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

On March 15, 2019, at approximately 2149 hours, Kwak was working as a cage supervisor at the Bellagio poker room casino cage. Kwak was advised by other cage employees that they had been robbed, and the cage employees pointed towards the suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, walking towards the sports book. Kwak could not give a basic description of Cohen since he only saw Cohen from the rear, but Kwak stated Cohen was wearing a black beanie and a black hooded sweatshirt. Kwak watched Cohen walk towards the north valet. Kwak did not witness the actual robbery.

Blanca Magallon

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0100 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Blanca Magallon at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was Detective Zinger. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Magallon's boyfriend was a registered guest at the Bellagio and she was returning to the hotel after a birthday celebration with friends. As Magallon drove into the north valet lot she pulled in the lane closest to the curb and doors. A white Mercedes was parked in front of her and she observed a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, in the car and believed him to be a valet attendant.

Magallon looked down at her phone and when she looked up she observed Cohen walking toward her. She described Cohen as a white male, wearing all black, with a white patch on his face. As Cohen reached Magallon's vehicle he yanked on the door handle on the front driver's side door. As Cohen attempted to open the door, Magallon observed either police officers or security officers nearby their location. She looked toward the officers and heard tapping on her window. As she looked toward the window, she saw Cohen had a gun pointed at her. Magallon

believed she was going to die. She looked down toward the ground as she waited for something to happen.

Magallon heard a gunshot near where Cohen was standing, but she continued to look down believing Cohen had shot at her. Magallon then heard another gunshot, and a few seconds later she looked up and saw the police officers looking inside her vehicle. The officers instructed Magallon to exit her vehicle and to go inside the Bellagio.

Magallon did not see who fired the first shot, but heard the first shot come from the driver's side of her vehicle where Cohen had been standing.

NLVPPD Detective Marcus Cook

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0103 hours, Detective Colon conducted an audio recorded interview with Detective Cook at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Scott Nicholas. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Detective Cook was located in the Bellagio's surveillance room working on a case related to his position with LVMPD's Central Intelligence Unit when the surveillance room officers received a call from casino floor personnel informing them there had just been a robbery in the poker room.

The Bellagio surveillance team located the robbery suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, walking through the casino. Detective Cook left the surveillance room with the intent of apprehending Cohen.

When Detective Cook reached the valet area, Cohen was being taken into custody. Detective Cook assisted with crime scene preservation.

Charles Powell

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0137 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Charles Powell at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Powell and his girlfriend, Maria Alvarez, were walking towards the Bellagio valet to pick up his car, and as he walked towards the top of the ramp he looked down to retrieve his valet ticket and heard the officers in valet say, "Hold it," or a similar phrase. Powell then heard gunshots, but did not physically see anyone shoot. He and his girlfriend sought cover behind a pillar and waited for the situation to calm down before going inside the Bellagio.

Powell did not see who the officers were yelling at and he did not see anyone yelling at the officers. Powell heard a total of two gunshots come from the same area of valet.

Maria Alvarez

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0138 hours, Detective Zinger conducted an audio recorded interview with Maria Alvarez at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Alvarez was in the north valet area of the Bellagio to retrieve her vehicle. Alvarez stood near the ticket machine and saw three or four officers on bicycles near the entry doors. Alvarez said the officers were wearing yellow shirts and helmets, and it was clear to her that they were officers.

Alvarez heard one of the officers say, "Stop. Don't touch," then the officers threw down their bicycles and started to run. Alvarez turned around and saw a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, next to a vehicle with an open door, pull a gun and fire. Alvarez said she saw the flash from the gun. Alvarez could not further describe Cohen because of the lighting in the area. Alvarez said Cohen held the gun above the car level, but did not see where it was pointed. Alvarez heard two or three gunshots all from the same area. After Cohen fired the first shot, Alvarez went to the ground and could not see anything else. Alvarez said everything happened so fast and that it was scary.

Christine Knight

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0148 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Christine Knight at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Knight and her husband had pulled into the middle lane of valet, and while they waited for the valet attendant her husband got out of the car. Knight saw police officers to her right jump off their bicycles and start yelling. She looked in the direction the officers were yelling and saw the side profile of a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, pointing a gun approximately five feet away from the passenger side of her car. Knight saw the muzzle flash and heard a gunshot. She believed the gun was pointed at the police officers. Knight heard a second gunshot and her husband got back in the car.

When she heard the gunshots she was concerned about her husband because he was still outside the car. She heard the officers give verbal commands to Cohen. Knight did not see anyone else with Cohen, but saw a female in a black car near Cohen who appeared stressed and concerned.

Kevin Knight

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0156 hours, Detective Zinger conducted an audio recorded interview with Kevin Knight at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Knight, who was driving a red Tesla, pulled into the north valet at the Bellagio behind a white van, exited his vehicle, and while he was standing near his driver's side he heard bicycles drop

to the ground. Knight saw officers wearing yellow and heard one of them yell either, "Get down," or, "Back up," or something similar. Knight looked to his right and saw a male, later identified as Michael Cohen, who he described as being approximately 5'7" or 5'8" tall, with black hair, wearing all black clothing. Knight said Cohen had his right arm below the window line of a black car he (Cohen) was standing near. Knight said as soon as the officer yelled Cohen's arm came up and he saw two muzzle flashes from what Knight said sounded like a small caliber (handgun). Knight believed he heard another gunshot, but could not be sure because there was a lot of screaming. As soon as Knight saw the flashes, he ran back to his car and jumped inside with his wife. Knight said Cohen held the gun in his right hand and when he fired it was pointed either at the black car or the officers, both of which were in his line of fire. Knight said Cohen held the gun at a ninety degree angle, or parallel to the ground when he fired.

Knight described his vehicle as being approximately five feet in front of and one lane over from the black vehicle Cohen was standing near. Knight said Cohen was standing at the driver's side of that black vehicle. Knight saw that someone inside the black vehicle and believed it was a female.

Knight described the officers as wearing yellow and that they looked like "bike cops." Knight never saw any of the officers draw a weapon since he fled into his vehicle.

Hunter Walker

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0202 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Hunter Walker at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Also present for the interview was Walker's mother, Kelly Paiz. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Walker and his girlfriend, Shelby Kee, were waiting for Paiz to pick them up in valet. Walker noticed several police cars leave the valet while multiple bicycle officers stayed in the valet by the hotel entrance. Walker assumed the officers were looking for someone.

Walker saw four officers move forward, and one of the officers yelled, "Hey you, stop right there!" Walker looked towards the area where the cars were parked and saw a gun and heard a gunshot. Walker laid on top of his girlfriend to block her. He heard another gunshot then directed his girlfriend to hide behind a planter. Walker could not describe the male holding the gun as he was focused on the gun and saw a muzzle flash.

While Walker and his girlfriend were behind the planter an officer went to them and directed them into the hotel. Walker saw the officer had an injury to his face. Walker was appreciative of the four officers who addressed the gunfire and protected him.

Shelby Kee

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0214 hours, Detective Zinger conducted an audio recorded interview with Shelby Kee at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Kee and her boyfriend were in the north valet area of the Bellagio sitting on a bench just west of the entry doors when she saw approximately three police officers wearing yellow shirts that possibly said Metro Police on the back. Kee said they were clearly identifiable as police officers. Kee heard one of the officers yell, "Hey!" then they pulled out their guns. Kee said she heard two gunshots that possibly came from the valet area. Kee said as soon as she heard the gunshots her boyfriend pushed her to the ground behind a pot. Kee said she heard the gunshots more from the center of the valet area, as opposed to where the officers were. Kee did not see specifically where the gunshots came from or who fired them.

Joanna Piano

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0225 hours, Detective Zinger conducted an audio recorded interview with Joanna Piano at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Piano was working as a valet cashier in the north valet area of the Bellagio, and was standing next to her valet supervisor near the booth just east of the hotel entry doors when a look on his face caused her to turn around. Piano observed a male (Michael Cohen) in a black jacket fire a gun, and described seeing the fire (muzzle flash) come out of the gun. Piano remembered Cohen standing in between two vehicles, one possibly being burgundy. Piano believed Cohen was holding the gun in his right hand and that he knew where the officers were because he pointed right at them. Piano described Cohen as having the gun held out at chest level. After Cohen fired, Piano ducked down and heard more gunfire, but could not remember how many rounds. Piano said Cohen fired the first round.

Hambartsum Mamikonyan

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0229 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Hambartsum Mamikonyan at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Mamikonyan drove his taxi into the valet area to drop off a customer. Mamikonyan heard gunshots and smelled an odor similar to burning matches. Mamikonyan did not see anyone with a gun or witness the shooting; he only heard the shooting while he was dropping off his customer.

Dennis Minarchan

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0239 hours, Detective Zinger conducted an audio recorded interview with Dennis Minarchan at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Minarchan was working as a valet supervisor in the north valet area of the Bellagio Hotel when he heard undistinguishable yelling he believed was coming from police officers that were standing near the entry doors. Minarchan then observed a white male, later identified as Michael Cohen, with a bandage on part of his face, pull a small, black handgun out of his

waistband. Minarchan then looked in the direction Cohen was pointing the firearm and observed two or three police officers on bicycles draw their weapons. Minarchan believed he heard approximately two or three gunshots as he looked back and forth between Cohen, the officers, and the valet podium. Minarchan said Cohen had the gun fully extended toward the officers. Minarchan observed Cohen fall between two vehicles and the officers slowly approached him. Minarchan described the officers present as wearing yellow polo tops which said "Metro" on the back, and black pants.

Domenico Calicich

On March 16, 2019, at approximately 0241 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Domenico Calicich at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Calicich was working in the Bellagio north valet and attending to a customer in the second lane when he heard police officers scream and then gunshots. He got into the nearest car in order to hide. After the shooting, an officer asked Calicich if he was okay. Calicich went back to the valet booth to resume work.

Calicich did not see the shooting or see anyone with a gun.

Officer Devin McHale

On March 20, 2019, at approximately 1918 hours, Detective Mendoza conducted an audio recorded interview with Officer McHale at the CCAC Bike Station located inside The Waldorf Astoria at 3752 S. Las Vegas Boulevard. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Myron Hamm. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

On March 15, 2019, Officer McHale arrived in the north valet of the Bellagio along with his partner, Officer Lea, to assist LVMPD detectives with a kidnapping call. As they met with Officers Ellis and Escobar in the north valet area, Officer McHale was informed via police radio by a detective that a robbery suspect, later identified as Michael Cohen, exited the casino and was in the north valet area. A description of Cohen was broadcast and officers located him. Officers issued verbal commands to Cohen; Cohen stepped back, raised a firearm, and shot one time at the officers.

As Officers McHale, Lea, and Ellis retreated away from Cohen, Officer Escobar went toward the rear of a vehicle and followed Cohen. Officer McHale ran around the rear of a vehicle and went to Officer Escobar's location. Officer McHale saw Cohen down on the ground and believed Officer Escobar placed handcuffs on Cohen. "Shots fired" was broadcast over the radio and officers requested medical aid for Cohen.

Officer McHale had his firearm out as he went to Officer Escobar's location, but stated he did not fire his weapon. Officer McHale was not aware that anyone else fired a shot other than Cohen.

Officer Gabriel Lea

On March 20, 2019, at approximately 1939 hours, Detective Mendoza conducted an audio recorded interview with Officer Lea at the CCAC Bike Station located inside The Waldorf Astoria at 3752 S. Las Vegas Boulevard. Also present for the interview was LVPPA representative Myron Hamm. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

On March 16, 2019, Officer Lea and his partner, Officer McHale, arrived at the Bellagio to assist with a kidnapping call. Officers met up with Officers Escobar and Ellis, also assigned to bicycle patrol, in the north valet of the Bellagio. Officer Lea saw a subject (Michael Cohen) exit the Bellagio doors. Officer Lea noticed a bandage on Cohen's face as he watched him in the valet area, but did not pay much attention to him. Moments later, Officer Lea received information on his patrol radio that Cohen had robbed the Bellagio and to apprehend him. Cohen was then at a BMW sedan that had pulled into the valet area.

As officers approached Cohen, he was given verbal commands to stop. As Officer Lea and the assisting officers walked toward the front end of the BMW, Cohen raised a firearm and fired one time at the officers. Officer Ellis was struck by the gunfire as the other officers backed away to find cover. Officer Lea saw Officer Escobar go around the trunk of the BMW, but then lost sight of him. Officer Lea stated he did not hear any other gunshots and did not know Officer Escobar had fired his weapon. Officers Ellis, McHale, and Lea moved toward Cohen and he was found lying on the ground. Officer Lea stated he did have his firearm out as he moved toward Cohen's location, but he did not fire his weapon. Medical personnel were requested to the scene to assist Cohen.

XV. TIMELINE

The below timeline based on Bellagio video surveillance footage is a reconstruction of events which transpired on Friday, March 15, 2019, in relation to the fatal OIS that occurred at 3600 Las Vegas Boulevard S.

Time (hours)	Description of Event/Action
2142:50	A male subject, later identified as Michael Cohen, approached the Bellagio poker room cage. Cohen appeared to show the cashier a firearm multiple times. The cashier handed Cohen poker chips and cash.
2144:58	Cohen walked away from the poker room cage.
2146:03	Cohen exited the casino through the north valet doors.
2146:12	Cohen entered an unoccupied white Mercedes-Benz sedan that was parked in the valet area. Cohen immediately exited the vehicle and walked towards an occupied black BMW sedan that was behind the Mercedes-Benz.
2146:20	Cohen attempted to enter the BMW, but the driver would not open the door. The driver drove the car forward closer to four LVMPD bicycle officers that were located near the door.
2146:40	A Central Intelligence Unit sergeant notified the officers in the north valet of the robbery in the casino and told them the suspect was in front of them. Officers dropped their bicycles and approached Cohen who was still by the BMW.
2146:41	Cohen fired one round from his handgun, striking Officer Ellis.
2146:43	Officer Escobar fired one round at Cohen, striking him in the head.
