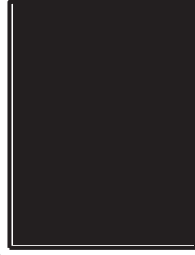

The below timeline based on computer aided dispatch (CAD) provides a reconstruction of events which transpired on Tuesday May 5, 2020, in relation to the OIS that occurred at 3000 South Sandhill Road.

V. SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT AND INVESTIGATION

Scene Overview

Investigative Summary

At approximately 1035 hours, a 9-1-1 call was placed from 3000 South Sandhill Road. The PR stated a white male adult (Justin Charland) in his 30's was outside his apartment (227) yelling and talking to himself. The PR further stated the male had been in the military and police had been to his apartment before.

The call taker was able to locate two previous events at the apartment complex associated with apartment #227 and identified the male as Charland. Per the previous calls, Charland was known to be schizophrenic. Officer Maman was assigned to the call and Officer Segura assigned himself. Officer Maman arrived in the area and waited for Officer Segura to arrive.

Ibarra, a maintenance worker, walked up the stairs to Charland's apartment to give him a mailbox key he had made for Charland. He heard Charland yelling at him. Ibarra stopped and observed that Charland was holding a large sword in his hands. According to Ibarra, Charland was very upset and Ibarra decided to leave Charland alone and return to his apartment.

As Ibarra walked towards his apartment, he observed Officers Maman and Segura walking towards Charland's apartment. As the officers approached, they heard Charland yelling at Ibarra. Officer Segura made verbal contact with Charland who was standing on the landing of the second floor and holding a large sword. The officers instructed Ibarra to go inside and asked Charland to drop the sword.

Officer Segura attempted to engage Charland in a conversation and calm him down for several minutes. Charland refused to drop the sword and yelled at the officers. After a few minutes, Charland walked down the stairs and towards the officers. Officer Segura gave Charland verbal commands to drop the sword, but he did not comply. Charland walked in a quick pace towards Officer Segura who backed away trying to maintain distance. Charland continued to close the distance which resulted in Officer Segura discharging his firearm.

After the gunshots, Charland dropped the sword and fell to the ground. Officers Segura and Maman continued to give Charland verbal commands so they could take him into custody. The officers requested medical personnel and provided first aid until paramedics arrived.

VI. INTERVIEW SUMMARIES

Subject Officer

Subject officers may provide a recorded or written statement to FIT investigators; however, since the statement is voluntary, subject officers have the right to decline providing a statement to FIT investigators. If a statement, verbal or written, is provided to FIT investigators, it should be obtained from the subject officer(s) at least 48 hours after the incident. Note: The 48-hour waiting period may be waived by the subject officer.

Officer Vincen Segura

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1425 hours, Lieutenant Lloyd contacted Officer Segura to see if he would participate in an interview with FIT investigators; Officer Segura declined.

Witness Officer

Witness officers shall provide a recorded statement to FIT investigators. An officer who refuses to provide such information shall be deemed to be in violation of LVMPD policy sections 4/104.04 – Obedience and Insubordination, and 4/101.14 – Duty to Provide Statements. Witness officer statements will be taken at a date, time, and location determined by FIT investigators.

Officer Daphna Maman

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1412 hours, Detective Mendoza conducted an audio recorded interview with Officer Maman at 3000 South Sandhill Road. Also present for the interview was Detective Cesar Sedano and PPA Representative Chad Lyman. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Officer Maman was assigned to a disturbance call at 3000 S. Sandhill Road #227. Officer Maman arrived in the complex and waited for Officer Segura to arrive before she approached the

residence. Once Officer Segura arrived, they walked toward apartment #227. Officer Maman heard a male yelling. As they approached closer, she saw a male (Justin Charland) standing on the top stairwell and was holding a long sword. Officer Maman also saw another male subject on the walkway. Charland appeared to be yelling at the male down below. Officer Maman heard Charland yell, "I will kill" but it was unknown who Charland was referring to.

Charland walked down the stairs while holding the sword. Charland continued toward Officers Segura and Maman and they retreated away from Charland. As Charland rushed toward Officer Segura, he fired his weapon at Charland. Officer Maman said she was unable to fire her weapon as Officer Segura was in front of her. Officer Maman positioned herself to the right of Officer Segura. Charland dropped the sword and went to the ground. Officer Maman held Charland at gunpoint and gave him verbal commands to lie on his stomach. Charland went to his hands and knees and they instructed him multiple times to get on the ground. Charland collapsed to the ground and Officer Maman held Charland at gunpoint as Officer Segura secured him in handcuffs.

Civilian Witnesses

Raudel Ibarra

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1327 hours, Detective Sedano conducted an audio recorded interview in Spanish with Raudel Ibarra de Avila at 3000 S. Sandhill Road, Apartment 115. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

At approximately 1000 hours, Ibarra who works as the maintenance man for the Sandhill Apartments, went to the main office to obtain a mailbox key for a tenant by the name of Justin (Charland), who lives in apartment 227. Ibarra returned from the office and walked up the stairs that lead to apartment 227. While on the stairs Ibarra heard Charland yelling at him. Ibarra stopped and could see Charland holding a large sword with both hands.

Ibarra, fearing for his safety, decided to leave and head back to his apartment without giving Charland the key to the mailbox. Charland became upset and started to yell at Ibarra. Ibarra continued down the stairs and walked to his apartment as Charland came out onto the landing of his apartment and continued to yell at Ibarra.

Ibarra stated while he walked to his apartment, Charland yelled loudly and insulted him. Charland was yelling at Ibarra when the police officers arrived. Charland yelled at the officers as Ibarra watched from his apartment door. Ibarra recorded the incident on his cellular phone to provide it to the manager, so that the manager could see how Charland behaved.

Ibarra continued to record as Charland walked down the stairs and charged toward the officers. Ibarra then heard several gun shots and continued to record the incident as the officers took Charland into custody.

Aquette Lopez

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1342 hours, Detective Penny conducted an audio recorded interview with Aquette Lopez at 3000 S. Sandhill Rd., Apt# 117. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Lopez was inside of her apartment with her fiancé, Monte, and they were watching television. While inside, she heard a male (Charland) yelling outside. Lopez stated it was the same person who has been yelling off an on for the past three weeks. While she was in the restroom, Monte yelled for her to come to the front of the apartment.

Lopez walked to the front of her apartment and looked out of the window and saw Charland standing on the top of his stairs holding a machete. She saw two officers in uniform standing below and were giving Charland commands to drop the knife. Both officers hand their guns drawn but were holding them at their sides.

Charland refused to cooperate with the officers and continued yelling several obscenities at the officers. The officers told Charland to drop the weapon several times and he still refused. Charland started to run down the stairs toward the officers. Both officers retreated and Charland raised the machete above his head and continued to run toward them. Charland also yelled that he was going to kill them.

Lopez moved away from her window and heard three gunshots. When she looked outside, she saw Charland was on the ground and bleeding. The officers provided him medical care until other people arrived.

Brenda Flores

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1320 hours, Detective Ubbens conducted an audio recorded interview with Brenda Flores at 3000 Sandhill Road. Below is a summary of the interview; for complete details refer to the interview transcript.

Flores was working as a bus driver for RTC and was assigned to pick up a passenger at 3000 Sandhill Road. While she was outside of the bus to pick up the passenger, she saw a male (Charland) standing outside the doorway of an upstairs apartment. The male yelled profanities and held, what she described as, a large metal object.

She heard patrol officers give the male several verbal commands. The male ran down the steps, with the metal object, towards the officers. Flores began to walk away to get out of the area and heard several gunshots. She did not physically see the shooting because she was attempting to leave the area.

VII. PUBLIC SAFETY STATEMENT

Officer Vincen Segura

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1317 hours, Detective Penny interviewed Sergeant Nordstrom in reference to the Public Safety Statement (PSS) he obtained from Officer Segura. Below is the transcript of the interview.

Note: Detective Penny is designated by (BP) and Sergeant Nordstrom is designated by (JN).

BP: Operator, this is dd...Detective Penny with the Force Investigation Team conducting a Public Safety Statement interview with Sergeant Jayme, J-A-Y-M-E Nordstrom, N-O-R-D-S-T-R-O-M, P# 8254, call sign [REDACTED]. Date of hire [REDACTED]-2004. Works out of Southeast Area Command, squad SE24. RDOs Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, shift 0630 to 1630. This interview is in reference to a Public Safety Statement relating to an officer-involved shooting. Public Safety Statement was from Officer Segura. Uh, the OIS occurred on 05-05 of 2020, at approximately 1115 hours, uh, in the area of 3000 South Sandhill, under event number 200500021784. Today's date is 05-05 of 2020. Current time is 1317 hours. This statement is being conducted at...in the, uh, 3000 block of Sandhill. Uh, Sergeant Nordstrom, are you aware this interview is being recorded?

JN: Yes.

BP: Okay. Can you go over the Public Safety Statement for me please?

JN: Yes, I can. Read off my card. First question: "Did you discharge your firearm?" The answer for A was, "Yes." Uh, oh, I'm sorry, correction. The answer was, "Yes."

Uh, when I asked him question 1A: "If so, what direction?" He stated he was facing east.

Uh, when I asked him his location he stated he was in the walkway between the two, um, buildings, and one of the buildings was B, the other one I'm not aware of the, uh, number.

BP: Okay.

JN: Ss...question 1, letter C: "How many shots do you think you fired?" He stated, "Three rounds."

Moving on to question #2: "Is anyone injured?" He stated, "Suspect."

And when I asked, uh, "Where were they located?" Located at the scene when we arrived, in between...in the walkway of the two apartments, and medical had already transported him.

3...question 3: "Are there any outstanding suspects?" He stated, "No."

When it got down to A, did not apply, uh, which was, "What direction and mode of travel?"

B: "How long have they been gone?" Did not apply.

C: "What crimes have they committed?" He stated, AWDW."

Uh, D as in...or, I'm sorry, question D: "What type of weapon do they have?" The answer was, "A sword."

Moving on to question #4: Uh, "Is it possible the suspect fired rounds at you?" The answer was, "No," and question 4A and B did not apply.

Moving on to question #5: "Do you know if any other officers discharged their firearms?" The answer was, "No."

Uh, A and B of question 5 did not apply.

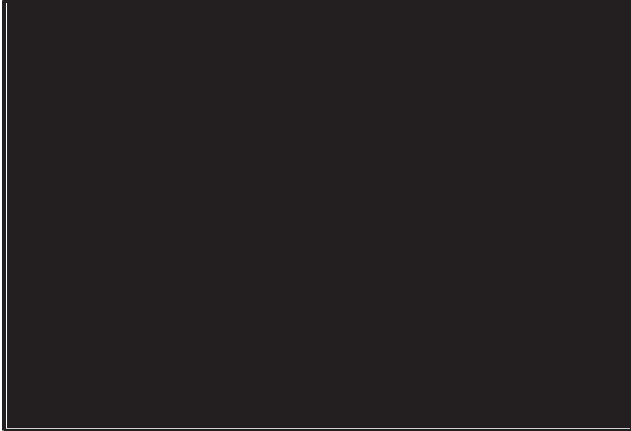
Question #6: "Are there any weapons or evidence that needs to be secured/protected?" The answer was, "Sword," and...and the location...Officer, um...officers were already out with the, uh, the sword that was located inside the alleyway of the...between those two apartments that I stated previously.

7: "Are you aware of any witnesses?" He stated, "A lot."

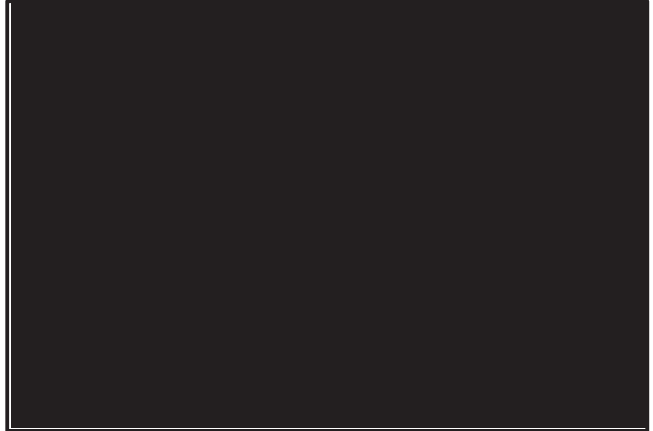
BP: Okay. Thank you. Uh, this will be end of the interview. Same persons present. Time is 1320 hours.

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1158 hours, CSA Browning responded to 3000 South Sandhill Road to photograph and document the scene, and photograph and collect evidence. IX. HOSPITAL

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1203 hours, CSA Ubbens responded to Sunrise Hospital to photograph and document the body of Charland, and photograph and collect evidence. For additional details, refer to Appendix XX to view CSA Ubbens' corresponding Crime Scene Investigation Report in its entirety, and Appendix XX to view CSA Ubbens' corresponding Evidence Impound Report in its entirety.

X. SCENE WALK-THROUGH

The purpose of the scene walk-through was to help investigators develop an understanding of the scene, including identifying officer locations at the time deadly force was used, identifying potential physical evidence, and re-creating a timeline of the incident.

Officer Vincen Segura

On May 5, 2020, at approximately 1421 hours, Officer Segura provided a walk-through of the scene in the presence of the following persons:

- 1) Lieutenant Lloyd
- 2) Sergeant Iacullo
- 3) Detective Alsup
- 4) Detective Colon
- 5) LVPPA attorney David Roger
- 6) LVPPA Representative Yant
- 7) CSI Director McLaughlin
- 8) CSI Supervisor Grammas

During the walk-through, which was not video or audio recorded, Officer Segura relayed the following information:

Officer Segura dropped a cone to represent his location as well as Charland's location at the time of the OIS. Officer Segura stated Charland advanced toward him and his partner and was armed with a sword.

Officer Segura stated he gave verbal commands for Charland to drop the sword but those commands were ignored. Officer Segura further stated he discharged his firearm because he was in fear for his life as well as his partners.

XI. OFFICER WEAPON COUNTDOWNS

On May 5, 2020, Officer Segura had his duty weapon counted down at 3000 South Sandhill Road. Involved and witness officers were photographed by CSI personnel for appearance purposes and their weapons were photographed for identification purposes.

Officer Vincen Segura

Officer Segura was dressed in a standard LVMPD long sleeve uniform. He wore LVMPD patches on each shoulder and an LVMPD badge over his left breast. Officer Segura wore a black duty belt with attached tools and equipment as part of his position in patrol. Officer Segura's handgun was carried on the right side of his body and secured in a holster.

Prior to countdown Officer Segura stated he carried 17 cartridges in the magazine loaded in his firearm and one cartridge in the chamber (17+1, 18 total).

At the completion of the countdown, it was determined Officer Segura discharged his firearm 3 times during this incident. Officer Segura's firearm, magazine, and cartridges were photographed and impounded by CSA Cromwell.

XII. BODY WORN CAMERA FOOTAGE SUMMARIES

Officer Vincen Segura

Officer Segura was wearing a body worn camera (BWC) at the time of the incident and the camera was activated. The camera was collected by Sergeant Iacullo and secured. The video footage captured was later viewed by detectives on May 5, 2020 at 1250 hours.

Officer Segura's camera footage depicted the following:

Officer Segura activated his BWC and drove to the apartment complex. Upon arriving, Officer Segura followed Officer Maman into the complex and parked. Officer Maman walked towards the apartment and Officer Segura followed her. As the officers walked between buildings, a male (Charland), could be heard yelling. Another male (Ibarra) was observed walking away from the front of Charland's apartment.

As Officer Segura turned toward the location of Charland's apartment, Charland was observed at the top of the stairs holding a sword. Officer Segura immediately instructed Charland to put the sword down. Charland did not comply with Officer Segura's verbal commands and continued to yell. Officer Maman was heard telling Ibarra to go inside his apartment a short time later.

Officer Segura spoke with Charland for approximately one minute and thirty seconds and asked him to drop the sword five times. After that time, Charland quickly descended the stairs with the sword in front of him. Once on the ground level, Charland walked quickly towards Officer Segura with the sword in front of him. Charland stated several times "shoot me" and told Officer Segura to run. Charland asked "what do you do bitch, what do you do?" as he closed the distance to Officer Segura. Officer Segura then discharged his firearm three times and Charland fell to the ground.

After Charland was placed in handcuffs, officers performed first aid until medical personnel arrived. Charland was transported to Sunrise Hospital.

Officer Daphna Maman

Officer Maman was wearing a BWC at the time of the incident and the camera was activated. The camera was collected by Sergeant Iacullo and secured. The video footage captured was later viewed by detectives on May 5, 2020 at 1235 hours.

Officer Maman's camera footage depicted the following:

Officer Maman was assigned to the call at 3000 South Sandhill Road and drove to the complex. She waited just outside the complex for Officer Segura to arrive. When Officer Segura arrived, both officers drove into the apartment complex and parked.

Both officers exited their vehicles and walked towards the apartment. A male (Charland) could be heard yelling as they walked. Another male (Ibarra) was observed walking and appeared to be looking towards Charland.

The officers located Charland who was standing at the top of the stairs holding a sword. Officer Maman asked the dispatcher to place a "Code Red" on the channel. Officer Segura began speaking with Charland and Officer Maman broadcast that Charland was holding a sword. She also advised the dispatcher that Charland was irate and yelling and asked for more officers and medical personnel. Officer Maman asked Ibarra to go inside his apartment and requested K-9 officers. She also advised the dispatcher that Charland was not listening to verbal commands, was in an elevated position and stated he would kill people.

Charland quickly descended the stairs and both officers began to back up. Charland advanced towards Officer Segura

XIII. THIRD PARTY VIDEO AND PHOTOGRAPHIC EVIDENCE

Cellular phone video footage was recorded by Ibarra. The footage was recorded in three separate clips all dated on May 5, 2020. The video clips were voluntarily provided by Ibarra.

The first clip was time stamped at 1040 hours and was approximately one minute and twenty six seconds in length. In the footage, Charland was not observed, however he can be heard yelling obscenities.

The second clip was time stamped at 1118 hours and was approximately three minutes and forty-seven seconds in length. Charland was observed standing at the top of the stairs and was yelling at the officers. Charland descends the stairs holding a sword in his hands. Charland was heard telling the officers to shoot him numerous times. Charland told the officers to run as he reached the bottom of the stairs and advanced towards the officers. Three gunshots were heard and Charland fell to the ground. The officers gave Charland verbal commands, took him into custody and provided first aid.

The third clip was time stamped at 1120 hours and was approximately one minute in length. The video depicted the officers continuing first aid.

XIV. AUTOPSY

On May 6, 2020, at approximately 0715 hours, under CCOCME case 20-2497, an autopsy was performed on the body of Charland at the CCOCME by Doctor Chundru.

- 3) Abrasions to the right forehead
- 4) Abrasions to the right elbow and forearm
- 5) Gunshot wound to the right chest
- 6) Gunshot wound to the right groin
- 7) Gunshot wound to the back of the right thigh

Upon the completion of toxicology testing, the following results were noted:

After a complete autopsy, Doctor Chundru opined Charland died as a result of multiple gunshot wounds. The manner of death was homicide.
