COLLISION DETAILS:

On June 1, 2022, at approximately 2:25 a.m., a fatal traffic collision occurred on South Jones Boulevard south of West University Avenue. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicate that a 2010 Ford Mustang was traveling southbound on Jones in the second through travel lane south of University Avenue. The pedestrian was lying in the travel lane occupied by the Mustang. The front of the Mustang made contact with the pedestrian, causing Fatal injuries. Emergency medical personnel determined the female pedestrian was beyond resuscitation and was pronounced deceased. The driver of the Mustang failed to remain on the scene of the collision and was located a short time later. The Driver of the Mustang showed signs of impairment and was subsequently booked into the Clark County Detention Center for DUI and Hit and Run related charges. The pedestrian's death will not be counted as a traffic-related fatality in LVMPD's jurisdiction for 2022, pending the completion of the Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner investigation. This collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD Collision Investigation Section.
