Assistant Sheriff Chris Jones Discusses April 29, 2020 OIS

In a [videotaped briefing](#), Assistant Sheriff Chris Jones provided additional details of the officer involved shooting that occurred on April 29, 2020 at Mile Marker 59 and North Las Vegas Blvd (Apex). At approximately 8:42 p.m., LVMPD Gangs Sergeant Timothy Stovall notified dispatch that a reckless driver was traveling over a hundred miles an hour northbound on I-15 at Cheyenne Avenue. Sergeant Stovall was driving an unmarked LVMPD vehicle and followed the reckless driver, later identified as 38-year-old Jesus Caballero-Herrera, to exit 58 at Apex.

Caballero-Herrera began traveling westbound on North Las Vegas Blvd where Sergeant Stovall conducted a vehicle stop using emergency lights and siren. Sergeant Stovall contacted Caballero-Herrera who stated he was having family problems. Caballero-Herrera further stated that he had a rifle in the car and wanted to die and asked Sergeant Stovall to shoot him. Dialogue continued for over six minutes before Caballero-Herrera grabbed his rifle and Sergeant Stovall fired. Additional units arrived and applied two tourniquets to Caballero-Herrera in an effort to save his life. Caballero-Herrera was transported to UMC Trauma where he was pronounced deceased.

This is the 6th officer involved shooting of 2020. The LVMPD Force Investigation Team is conducting the investigation into the officer's use of force in this incident. The findings will be forwarded to the Clark County District Attorney's Office for review.

An examination of this incident is being conducted by the LVMPD Critical Incident Review Team. This review focuses on policy, tactics and training as it relates to this use of force.
