



## **LVMPD Receives Grant funds to participate in the Joining Forces Program**

*Department of Public Safety-Office of Traffic Safety Grant Award*

The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department has received a grant in the amount of **\$228,000** from the Nevada Department of Public Safety, Office of Traffic Safety to support law enforcement's participation in the Joining Forces traffic safety campaigns during the coming year.

Joining Forces is a high visibility, multi-jurisdiction statewide effort to increase safety on Nevada's roads by increasing enforcement and awareness of traffic laws. The goal is to reduce crashes and save lives by focusing on impaired driving, distracted driving, seat belt use, speed, and pedestrian safety.

Thanks to this grant award the LVMPD will be able to team up with other area jurisdictions for a number of Joining Forces events from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.

Law enforcement personnel will continue to enforce traffic safety laws year-round as part of their commitment to reduce crashes and save lives. Whether you are a driver, a passenger, or a pedestrian, the LVMPD reminds everyone to make safety on our roadways a top priority.
