## Suspect Arrested in Connection with July Burglary to Senator Heller's Office

On July 16, 2017 at 9:06 a.m., The Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department received a call from an alarm company representative reporting a burglary alarm at the main entrance of an office building where Senator Dean Heller's office is located. During the preliminary investigation by patrol officers, a threatening note addressed to Senator Heller was discovered near the door to his office. Officers took a report for Threatening or Obscene Letters or Writing (NRS 207.180). The LVMPD has an on-going investigation into this incident.

Detectives are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a person of interest in this case. The person is described as a white male adult, between 50 to 60 years old, gray beard, heavy set, wearing a black baseball hat, short sleeve collared shirt and shorts.
