Body of Missing Woman Found

On October 5, 2020, LVMPD Missing Persons detectives began an investigation into the disappearance of 35-year-old Tiffany Booth and her boyfriend, 38-year-old Eduardo Clemente. The Las Vegas couple failed to report to work after taking a few days off to go on a trip. Additionally, a family member of Booth was unable to get a hold of her or Clemente to confirm if they were okay.

On October 8, a citizen located Booth's vehicle abandoned in a desert area near Ely, Nevada. Missing Persons detectives suspected foul play and the case was transferred to the LVMPD Homicide Section.

On October 19, the investigation led detectives to a location near Indian Springs where they found Tiffany Booth's body.

Clemente's whereabouts are still unknown, and he is now considered a suspect in Booth's death.

The cause and manner of death of the decedent, will be released by the Clark County Coroner's Office.
