COLLISION DETAILS:

On October 21, 2017, at approximately 12:36 am, a two vehicle traffic collision occurred on northbound Lamb Boulevard south of Charleston Boulevard. A LVMPD Traffic Officer responded to the collision scene and determined a 2012 Ford Fiesta was traveling north in the left turn lane of Lamb Boulevard and was approaching the intersection with Charleston Boulevard. A 2001 Toyota Camry was traveling north on Lamb Boulevard in the left travel lane and was approaching the intersection with Charleston Boulevard. The Ford changed lanes to the right and impacted the left front of the Toyota with the right front. The Ford came to rest in the intersection and the Toyota was parked in a nearby parking lot. Emergency medical services arrived at the collision scene and a female passenger from the Toyota was transported to UMC Trauma with injuries. The responding Traffic Officer completed a traffic collision investigation.

On October 30, 2017, the injured female passenger died and the LVMPD Fatal Detail was notified. Due to the delayed death, the Fatal Detail did not respond during the original collision investigation. This incident will not be counted as a traffic related fatality until the cause and manner of death is determined by the Clark County Coroner's Office. This collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD Collision Investigation Section.
