COLLISION DETAILS:

On Monday, May 03, 2021, at approximately 1:01 a.m., a fatal hit and run traffic collision occurred at Burnham Avenue and E. Flamingo Road. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicated that an unidentified Mercedes-Benz was traveling west on E. Flamingo Road approaching Burnham Avenue. A pedestrian was inside the marked crosswalk of E. Flamingo Road located on the west side of Burnham Avenue. The Mercedes-Benz struck the pedestrian and continued west on E. Flamingo Road, leaving the collision scene. A motorist traveling west on E. Flamingo Road approached the unresponsive pedestrian lying in the road and contacted police. Arriving medical personnel transported the pedestrian to the Sunrise Hospital and Medical Center Trauma Unit in critical condition. Despite all life-saving measures, the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries a short time after his arrival and was pronounced deceased by trauma staff. The death marked the 41st traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction for 2021. The collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD Collision Investigation Section.
