## COLLISION DETAILS:

On April 26, 2021, at approximately 6:52 AM, a call came into the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Dispatch Center of an Auto versus pedestrian collision on the private property of 1650 S. Casino Drive, Laughlin, Nevada, which is Don Laughlin's Riverside Resort RV Park. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicated that the driver of the 2004 Tiffin Allegro motor coach was backing out of his RV spot. He had a trailer attached to the motorcoach. He jackknifed the trailer and was in the process of pulling forward to straighten the trailer when he fell out of the driver's door. Witnesses stated that he landed on his head when he fell out of the motorcoach and did not move. The driver landed in the path of the motor coach's rear tires. The motorcoach was still in drive and slowly moving forward. The rear tires of the motorcoach ran over the driver. Medical personnel responded to the scene and determined the driver was beyond resuscitation. This collision marks the 40th traffic-related fatality in LVMPD's jurisdiction. This case remains under investigation by the LVMPD Collision Investigation Section.
