COLLISION DETAILS:

On October 16th, 2021, at approximately 1:50 a.m., a vehicle versus motorcycle collision occurred at East Cheyenne Avenue and North Lamb Boulevard. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicated a black 2015 Harley-Davidson Road Glide was traveling eastbound on Cheyenne Avenue, approaching the intersection with Lamb Boulevard in the center of three eastbound travel lanes (T2). A silver 2017 Dodge Durango was traveling southbound on Lamb Boulevard, approaching the intersection with Cheyenne Avenue in the center of three southbound travel lanes (T2). A collision occurred when the Dodge entered the intersection on a red traffic signal and crossed the Harley-Davidson's path of travel. The front of the Harley-Davidson struck the right side of the Dodge. After the collision, the Dodge failed to remain at the collision scene. The Dodge was located by responding LVMPD Patrol Officers. The driver of the Dodge showed signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for applicable charges.

Both motorcycle occupants sustained substantial injuries as a result of the collision and were transported to UMC Trauma by ambulance for further medical treatment. This collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD Collision Investigations Section.

Update

On December 29, 2021, the Clark County Office of the Coroner / Medical Examiner notified the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section that the operator of the Harley Davidson succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased on November 11, 2021. The rider's death marks the 150th traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction for the year 2021.
