## COLLISION DETAILS:

On December 28, 2021, at approximately 4:04 a.m., a fatal hit and run traffic collision occurred on E. Charleston Boulevard and S. Phyllis Street. The initial call to LVMPD dispatch was an unresponsive adult male in the roadway. Arriving medical personnel determined the adult male was beyond medical intervention and was deceased. Arriving Officers were able to locate evidence at the scene indicating a vehicle versus pedestrian collision with no vehicle on scene. Evidence at the scene and video surveillance indicated a pedestrian was walking/running eastbound E. Charleston Boulevard at Phyllis Street on the north side of the roadway. A 2019 GMC Box Delivery Truck was traveling westbound E. Charleston Boulevard in the westbound travel lanes. For an unknown reason the pedestrian entered the westbound travel lanes into the path of the GMC where no marked or unmarked crosswalks were provided. A collision occurred when the right front of the GMC struck the pedestrian knocking him to the ground sustaining fatal injuries. The driver and GMC did not remain at the collision scene or notify police/medical.

Detectives later located the GMC and the driver involved in this hit and run collision. The driver was arrested on hit and run charges. This collision will not be counted as a traffic related fatality until the completion of the investigation from the Clark County Coroner's Office. This collision remains under investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section.
