## COLLISION DETAILS:

On June 7, 2022, at approximately 2:05 a.m., a fatal auto versus pedestrian hit and run collision occurred at the intersection of N. Las Vegas Boulevard and N. Lamb Boulevard. Evidence at the scene, witness statements, and video of the collision indicated a pedestrian using a walker was crossing N. Las Vegas Boulevard at N. Lamb Boulevard from north to south in the marked crosswalk on the west side of the intersection. A Black 2019 Chevrolet Malibu was traveling eastbound N. Las Vegas Boulevard approaching the intersection. The left front of the Chevrolet struck the pedestrian causing the pedestrian to be projected into the windshield and onto the roadway. The driver of the Chevrolet failed to stop after the collision fleeing the scene. Arriving medical personnel determined the pedestrian was beyond medical intervention and he was pronounced deceased at the collision scene. Officers located the Chevrolet a short time later and made contact with the driver. The driver displayed signs of impairment, failed Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, and was arrested for DUI and Hit and Run charges.

The pedestrian's death marks the 66th traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction for the year 2022. This collision remains under investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section.
