Update

On June 13, 2022, the Clark County Office of the Coroner / Medical Examiner contacted the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section notifying them that despite all life-saving efforts, the Kawasaki's rider succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased. The death of the Kawasaki rider marks the 71st traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction. The collision remains under investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section.

Original Press Release

On June 12, 2022, at approximately 10:42 PM, a critical injury vehicle collision occurred on North Rainbow Boulevard, south of Yorktown Road. Evidence at the scene and statements from witnesses indicate that a 2015 Kawasaki Ninja traveled south on North Rainbow Boulevard, south of Yorktown Road. A 2017 Chevrolet Malibu traveled north on North Rainbow Boulevard in the center turn lane. A collision occurred when the Chevrolet conducted a left turn into 2451 North Rainbow Boulevard, crossing the path of the Kawasaki. The collision redirected the Kawasaki onto the private property, ejecting the rider. Arriving medical personnel transported the Kawasaki's rider to University Medical Center's Trauma Center, where he remains in critical condition. The Chevrolet's driver remained at the collision scene and showed no signs of impairment. The collision remains under investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section.
