COLLISION DETAILS:

On June 29, 2022, at approximately 11:16 p.m., a vehicle versus pedestrian hit, and run collision occurred on East Sahara Avenue, east of Chapman Drive. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicated that a possible newer 4-door sedan was traveling eastbound on Sahara Avenue east of Chapman Drive. A pedestrian was in the roadway, outside of a marked crosswalk. A collision occurred when the pedestrian entered the vehicle's path of travel and was struck by the front portion of the vehicle. The pedestrian was projected forward and onto the ground. The vehicle involved in the collision failed to remain at the collision scene and was last seen traveling eastbound on Sahara Avenue.

The pedestrian sustained life-threatening injuries and was transported to Sunrise Hospital and Medical Center by ambulance. Despite all life-saving measures, the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at Sunrise Hospital by medical staff.

The pedestrian's death marks the 75th traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction for 2022. This collision remains under investigation by the LVMPD's Collision Investigation Section.
