## COLLISION DETAILS:

On July 30, 2022, at approximately 9:40 p.m., an automobile versus pedestrian collision occurred on West Charleston Boulevard, west of the intersection of Essex Drive. Evidence at the scene and witness statements indicated that a male pedestrian was walking northbound across all lanes of West Charleston Boulevard outside of a marked crosswalk. A collision occurred when a dark in color westbound sedan struck the pedestrian. The sedan fled the scene without stopping to render aid. Arriving emergency medical services transported the pedestrian to University Medical Center's Trauma Unit for medical treatment. Despite all life-saving measures, the pedestrian succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

The pedestrian's death marks the 84th traffic-related fatality in the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's jurisdiction for the year 2022. The collision remains under investigation by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department's Collision Investigation Section.
