Southern Nevada Human Trafficking Task Force Partners

Family and Child Treatment (FACT) is a therapy service provider specialized in treating complex trauma due to sexual abuse, domestic violence, sex trafficking, and child sex trafficking. Additionally, FACT works in collaborative partnerships to serve diverse populations and provide services throughout the vast community. They provide little to no cost individual, group, and family therapy services for victim-survivors of abuse. FACT employs licensed clinicians who are Certified Clinical Trauma Professionals, and provides various options for therapy, including EMDR, Sand Tray Therapy, Art and Play Therapy, and other trauma-focused therapies.

Hookers for Jesus/Pink Chair is a survivor-led faith based non-profit organization providing support and resources for victims of human trafficking. Their Destiny & Dream House program provides long term transitional housing and trauma informed care through counseling, education, jail classes (CCDC), equine therapy, art therapy, job readiness, fitness instruction, life-skills training, vocational college, and educational opportunities. All services are offered free of charge and include up to four years of housing programs, across two housing programs.

The Shade Tree is a 24-hour accessible shelter which offers life changing services to victims of domestic violence, sexual abuse, human trafficking, elder abuse, and street violence. Their doors are open to women (with or without children), and unaccompanied youth of any gender facing economic hardship who lack an adequate place to live. Programs and services at The Shade Tree promote stability, dignity, and self-reliance, while escaping the cycle of abuse, homelessness, or violence. The Shade Tree partners with Noah's Animal House, located onsite, to provide pet services for clients.
