The undersigned makes the following declarations subject to the penalty of perjury and says: That I am a peace officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Clark County, Nevada, being so employed for a period of approximately 3 year(s).

That I learned the following facts and circumstances which lead me to believe that the above named subject committed or was committing the offenses above at the location of 11011 W CHARLESTON LAS VEGAS NEVADA 89135 and that the offense(s) occurred at approximately 04:30 hours on the 27th day of September, 2023.

Details for Probable Cause:

BWC

On 09/27/2023 at approximately 0430 hours, I, Officer J. DeJarnette P#18219 was operating as marked and uniformed patrol unit 1V16. Sergeant J. Beckman P#9014 was operating as marked and uniformed patrol supervisor 697TV. I was dispatched to a Other Disturbance call at Red Rock Resort, 11011 west Charleston LVN, 89135. The details of the call stated a male wearing a white shirt and black pants was at the cashier cage refusing to leave the property.

Sergeant Beckman arrived and contacted a security officer. The security officer advised Sergeant Beckman of the subject. The security officer stated the male in question, who was later identified as Shane Tamura (DOB: PII [REDACTED] 1998) ID# 8634801, was at a table gambling. Security approached Shane and requested to see his ID card. Shane refused to show his ID card to security and they asked him to leave the property.

Shane walked to the cashier cage to collect his winnings. The cashier cage clerk requested to see Shane's ID card, as is common practice for them due to Shane requesting approximately \$5,000.00. Shane also refused to show his ID card to the cashier cage clerk. At this point, security called police for assistance as Shane was refusing to leave property without his money, but was also refusing to show his ID card to collect his money.

Sergeant Beckman observed Shane speaking with other security officers. Sergeant Beckman observed Shane to appear agitated and talking over the security officers. Sergeant Beckman observed Shane reach out towards a security officer with his left hand. Sergeant Beckman believes Shane was attempting to grab a security officer. Sergeant Beckman used an empty hand tactic and escorted Shane towards a wall to detain him.

Shane was obstructive with Sergeant Beckman and ignored his commands to separate his legs and place his hands behind his back. Shane was eventually placed in handcuffs without incident and escorted to the security holding cell.

Wherefore, Declarant prays that a finding be made by a magistrate that probable cause exists to hold said person for preliminary hearing (if charges are a felony or gross misdemeanor) or for trial (if charges are misdemeanor).

At this time, I arrived and spoke with Shane. Shane was asked for his name and birthday multiple times and refused initially. After being advised he will be placed under arrest if he does not identify himself, he provided his name and birthday. Red Rock Security Officer Devin Wofford advised Shane of the trespass warning pursuant to NRS 207.200.

Shane was escorted out of the casino and into the parking lot to a marked patrol vehicle. Shane was advised he must leave property as he has now been trespassed. Shane was advised the parking lot is also casino property and he must go to at least the sidewalk or he will be subject to arrest. Shane understood and stated he is leaving. Shane was taken out of handcuffs and advised he is free to leave.

Instead of leaving property, Shane leaned on the patrol vehicle and threw his ID card on the hood. Shane was given back his ID and told to leave property or he will be arrested. Shane still refused to leave and asked how he will get his money. Shane was advised to contact corporate in the morning to set up a time to pick his money up. Shane did not agree with this and requested his money now. Shane was again advised to leave or he will be arrested. Shane still refused to leave property and he was subsequently placed under arrest for Trespass After Verbal Warning.

It was determined for Shane to be booked into CCDC as he has shown already his refusal to leave property and he will likely be a recurring issue if he were to be cited and released.

Due to the fact Shane did, after due notice, remain on property after warning not to trespass by a representative of the owner, Devin Wofford on 09/27/2023, said warning being issued due to Shane refusing to leave property after refusing to identify himself to security officers in order to gather his winnings and being released with his winnings in the form of casino chips and still refusing to leave property thereafter, he is charged with Trespass.

Shane was transported to CCDC and booked accordingly.

GUEST REFUSED TO PRESENT ID AND WAS ASKED TO VACATE THE PROPERTY. AFTER REFUSING TO LEAVE I ADVISED THE GUEST THE TRESPASS WARNING IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE NEVADA REVISED STATUTE 207.200. GUEST STILL REFUSED TO LEAVE AND STATED HE WILL WAIT FOR METRO. METRO ARRIVED ON SCENE AT APPROX 0445 HRS TO ADVISE GUEST HE MUST SHOW PROPER ID TO CASH OUT. GUEST STILL REFUSED AND PLACED GUEST IN MECHANICAL RESTRAINTS. GUEST WAS ESCORTED TO HOLDING ROOM PER METRO. AT APPROX 0450 HOURS I READVISED GUEST THE TRESPASS WARNING FOR A SECOND TIME.

In *Reno Newspapers v. Sheriff*, 126 Nev. 211, 218, 234 P.3d 922, 927 (2010), the Nevada Supreme Court recognized that an individual's privacy must be balanced with the public's general right to open government, "especially because private and personal information may be recorded in government files"). Later, in *Clark County Sch. Dist. v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, -- Nev. --, 429 P.3d 313, 319-20 (2018), the Court adopted a balancing test in which the burden shifts to the requester of a record if the public agency demonstrates a "nontrivial personal privacy interest" including "intrusion[s] into a person's reasonable expectation of privacy, seclusion, or solitude." Privacy interests include information that may cause "embarrassment, shame, stigma, [or] harassment" or "endangerment, or similar harm." *Las Vegas Metro. Police Dep't v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, 136 Nev. Ad. Op. 86, -- P.3d -- (2020). Medical information, personnel files, details about sexual orientation, and other information about a person's life give rise to privacy interests. *Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, 136 Nev. Adv. Op. 5, -- P.3d -- (2020).

The Nevada Supreme Court equates the type of information that should be withheld under the Nevada Public Records Act with the common law tort of invasion of privacy. *Clark County Sch. Dist.*, *supra*, at 708, 549 P.3d at 320. "The tort of invasion of privacy embraces four different tort actions: '(a) unreasonable intrusion upon the seclusion of another; or (b) appropriation of the other's name or likeness; or (c) unreasonable publicity given to the other's

private life; or (d) publicity that unreasonably places the other in a false light before the public.” *Franchise Tax Bd. of Cal. v. Hyatt*, 133 Nev. 826, 842, 407 P.3d 717, 733 (2017), *overturned on other grounds by Franchise Tax Bd. v. Hyatt*, 139 S. Ct. 1485 (2019) *quoting* RESTATEMENT (SECOND) OF TORTS § 652A (1977); *see also PETA v. Bobby Berosini, Ltd.*, 111 Nev. 615, 629, 895 P.2d 1269, 1278 (1995), *overruled on other grounds by City of Las Vegas Downtown Redev. Agency v. Hecht*, 113 Nev. 644, 650, 940 P.2d 134, 138 (1997).
